PRESIDENTS REPORT

First of all may I welcome you to County Hall tonight to Annual General Meeting of the Association? This year we have decided to have the meeting at a central location rather than in the vicinity of the Presidents club to hopefully improve the attendance.

I now present my report for 2008.

This year commenced with a successful Level 2 meet in January. I would like to thank all those who helped in any way to the success of the event. Janice will obviously give more details in her report. Following on from the Level 2 meet the Inter Association competition was held at Everton Park and as President I was proud to make presentations on behalf of the association and proud of the team who were again victorious. Congratulations to the swimmers and Steve Heaps and Alan Harper the Management Team.

We have been in discussion for some time at the executive about providing clinics and courses for our clubs, in helping both the clubs maintain and improve their CPD opportunities, and assist the swimmers in their development. A swim Clinic was held in the summer and Sue arranged a Child Protection Course to tie in with County Time to Listen Course. We are currently working on a programme for 2009 so please ensure that your delegates provide the information to your clubs.

The October Level 3 meet again was very successful and an increased number of entries. The swimming league has had a successful year; sadly Water Polo seems to continue to be problematical. I would like to thank Paul Wilkinson for his efforts as Water Polo Secretary during the past year.

The year has not been without its problems, and attendance at some executive meetings has been disappointing. I would urge all our affiliated clubs to attend the meetings. We are not just organising competitions for our swimmers but I have committed the association to facilitate courses and training for our swimmers and volunteers, but this becomes difficult to provide if we do not know what our clubs are wanting.

Congratulations to all those who have achieved their officials qualifications. This is important and as regional co-ordinator I can only encourage clubs to persuade their parents to help in this capacity. Following on from the qualification could I encourage those officials who are Judge 1 and above to obtain/renew their licences at the appropriate time. Changes are coming with regard to licensed meets which will affect our association and it will be that all our officials will not only have to be qualified but also licensed. Congratulations also to Jane Whittle, Helen Jenkins and Craig Tinkler who received regional awards as volunteers.

Having been involved either as a technical official or as part of the management team at National Events, it has given me great pleasure to see many of our swimmers at the Age Group and Youth Championships, British Championships, Olympic Trials and the Masters Championships. We have a great deal of talent within our area and if we can all work together as clubs, the association, the county and the region, putting aside politics, and putting the swimmer first hopefully greater things can be achieved in the future.

Finally I would like to thank the other officers of the association and respective secretaries without whose hard work we would not be able to function, the delegates who attend our meetings and the clubs for supporting our activities and competitions.

As we have begun the festive season of Advent may I take this opportunity to wish you all a very Happy Christmas and a peaceful and successful 2009

HON TREASURERS REPORT

N.L.S.W.P.A. Treasurers Report AGM 2008

First of all, I would like to thank Garry Whittle for independently examining the books and producing this financial summary.

Can I just refer to the 2007 AGM Treasures report namely paragraph 4 regarding affiliation fees for 2007, in which I stated the matter had been resolved. Or so I thought. You will be aware that the 2007 AGM was on the 3rd December 2007. Well on 5th Dec 2007, I received the monthly statement only to discover that a cheque issued to the ASA in May 2007 and allegedly not received by them was cashed Nov 2007. This was a cheque that had a

replacement re-issued in July 2007, because the ASA said they had not received it. Well it seems it disappeared within the ASA in May and resurfaced within the ASA in Nov, and they decided to help themselves to it despite my request to return it to me should it resurface! So I fired off yet another really angry letter to the ASA, including a copy to David Sparks, demanding an explanation and a refund. This they did with `profuse apologies`. **So the matter of our 2007 affiliation fees which started on 5th Dec 2006 finally ended for good on the 10th December 2007 and not without a few harsh words from me to the ASA. These transactions are included in the 2008 financial summary.**

The finances for the 2007 – 2008 year followed the usual income/expenditure pattern showing a steady but notable increase in income from entries to the Age Groups, compared to the previous 2 years. This may reflect the increasing interest shown by swimmers and clubs in the competitions. All in all, a financially satisfactory year, largely due to all the hard work put in by other members of the Executive.

Finally if clubs wish to take advantage of reduced affiliation fees etc, for 2009 you have until the end of this month (Dec) to get your cheques to the new Treasurer, Mrs Gill Rankin, as I have resigned as Treasure for personal reasons. Thank you. Over to you Gill.

AGE GROUP SECRETARYS REPORT

Level 2 January/February

This proved very popular with the swimmers and once again was a successful meet. Many swimmers achieved Qualifying Times for Lancashire, Regional and National. The Programme of events was received well by the clubs and the length of the sessions was fine.

It has been suggested that it would be good to have a skins event but this is not practical with the programme at the moment.

From the meet the North Lancashire Team was selected for the Inter Association Competition.

Inter Association

The Inter Association was a closely fought competition this year. North Lancs. was trailing Liverpool at the end of all sessions bar one. Going into the final session North Lancs were just 3 points behind but ended up winners by 29 points after some excellent swims. The final points were: North Lancs. 685, Liverpool and District 656, Bolton and Manchester 575, North Midlands 563, Cumbria 417 and Central Lancs. 325. The team was led by Captains Jordan Theaker (Great Harwood) and Sarah Lucas (Newton Hall Blackpool) and Vice Captains Matthew Hargreaves (Blackburn) and Joanne Cutler (Preston). All four encouraged the swimmers throughout the competition. Thanks to Steve Heaps and Alan Harper, a great team in itself, for their commitment and drive. They did a fantastic job encouraging, motivating and praising the swimmers. Our swimmers broke 11 records during the weekend – Shauntelle Austin with 5 and several achieved NQT's. The response from the swimmers this year was good. The system worked sending out the information directly to the swimmers. However in the last week changes had to be made to the team through injury and illness. One or two swimmers even swam with a slight injury. North Lancashire Colours will be awarded to 23 swimmers this year.

Level 3

This is now a very popular meet and again was a success. The number of entries rose which did mean the sessions were longer but still fine as far as number of hours per day. The skins are the highlight of the weekend and again we were treated to some fine swimming.

One point of concern was again the eligibility of the swimmers for this event. The reason for running a Level 3 is to cater for those who are not fast enough to compete at Level 2, are in the bottom half of Level 2 or are on the way up! Sadly, it was noted that several swimmers entered the event with a much slower time than they had achieved (they were on the rankings!!). Although speeding tickets are awarded and the right swimmers do get the medals, it is not in the spirit of the sport to enter knowing that you are faster. The rankings are there for all to see and next year swimmers will be checked across the board.

Squadrons

Again this event has not taken place. However I will strive to get the event back in 2009. Some clubs prefer the summer months others autumn and winter. Obviously it is hard to please everyone. Watch this space!!

WATER POLO SECRETARYS REPORT

This year`s Water Polo League has been completed, there have been many exciting and close games, and to my knowledge all games have been played in a good sportsman like manner. However, teams still need to work on improving their promptness when sending in results, information and match sheets.

As you can see from the attached league table, this year has been a much more closely contested season, with results difficult to predict throughout the year. Preston and Lancaster have been fighting it out for the top spot in the league for most of the season, with the victor not decided until the final game of the year. Lancaster should once again be congratulated on holding their nerve and winning the 2008 North Lincs Water Polo League this year. First runners up this year are Preston; Burnley came in third position, with Blackpool fourth, and Fleetwood finishing fifth. I personally perceive the league to have been a success this year; however it can only improve if more teams become involved in Water Polo. There have been enquiries from two new teams hoping to join the league in the 2009 season, but I am hopeful we may be able to add further to this before next season begins. I suggest to all swimming clubs that can include water polo in their programme to consider entering the 2009 season, in order to expand and improve this league and make it a more comprehensive and challenging competition. In addition, if there is sufficient interest and it is feasible, I think we should look into the possibility of running a league or tournament for Junior Water Polo and/or Ladies Water Polo next year, if you know of a team that would be interested please contact me with your suggestions.
