## **TREASURERS REPORT**

The November 2011 Level 3 meet has again made a good profit which is showed in the report below, the profit is down by £1,363.08 this is due to entries being down a little , and pool hire increase of £238 and officials increase by £309.40. This is still a good profit for the association.

The upper level 3 in Jan/Feb 2012 still has invoices outstanding, but show an increase in the profit again this year. Pool hire at the higher rate and Saturdays hot food invoice are still outstanding but have been allowed in the figures so far. The Squadrons made a great income for NL again, and I feel it was really enjoyed by the swimmers; we still have some income outstanding. The official's expenses again are higher this year by £499.45 but we had a lot of officials giving their time for the association.

Affiliation has gone better this year. Only Chorley swimming club not paid this year`s affiliation. Please can we write to them?

The outstanding invoices for the t-shirts, has now been paid.

CPD courses that are being run by the NL affiliated clubs are going well and we find this is working well for the clubs, please see me or Sue for any information for CPD courses.

### **Squadrons:**
